



# What You Need to Know


- Order wide 66% of new members come through e-membership
- In Ohio, 56% of new members from e-membership last fraternal year
- Overwhelmingly, new members join to be active in programs
  - Your council MUST have an active program schedule to keep them active
- Treat them like other new members
  - Give them a mentor, explain things, introduce them
- E-membership is just another tool to have on your belt
  - Like any tool, it is only useful if you know how to use it.



## How the Process Works

- Catholic man joins online and receives 1<sup>st</sup> Supreme e-mail (then weekly)
- Supreme vets the new member then he appears in the Prospect tab
- State Online Director sends online form 100 to DMD
- DMD contacts member to verify desire to transfer
- Form 100 is sent to council
- Council contacts candidates and coordinates degree participation
- E-member attends degree
- Council transfers e-members thru Form 100 or Member Management





#### **Candidate Tab**

- The Candidate tab does not change the Online Membership process
- State and Local Councils cannot move Online Members from the prospect tab to the candidate



### Summary of Changes

- Change in the date the Form 365 is due to July 1.
- Form 944 has changed and is filed only once a year. It is due September 15.
- New Disability Exemption Form #1831. No doctor or member signature required. GK and FS attest. No annual recertification required.
- Roundtable Form #2629. Eliminated redundant Form #2630.
- Change in General Agent and territories.
- Insurance webinars now require seven participants. They do not have to be current Knights; however, they must be eligible to become members.



### Summary of Changes

- Change in membership requirements for Star Council 6% with a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 15. Your goal is based on intake only. No penalty for withdrawals or suspensions.
- Minor modifications to the requirements for the Silver and Gold Platter Awards as they relate to the State General Program requirements.
- New District Deputy Coordinator for the Columbus Diocese David Bogner.
- Removed all signatures from the Membership Cards.
- ASAP program Aid and Support After Pregnancy. Similar to RSVP except in this case for every \$500 a council gives to a pregnancy center, Supreme will give \$100 to the center as well (not to the council).

- Ensure the Form 185 from all councils are collected and submitted to Supreme, State, and Diocesan DD Coordinator by the July tour meeting.
- Attend the June District Deputy meeting in Columbus






