# A Little History...

1. The charity campaign has been an annual activity since the 1940s. The Super Cash Bonanza program began in 2005.
2. Past prizes included cars and trips. A Buick Century LaCrosse CX (or \$23,000) appeared on the 2004 ticket.



# A Little History...

3. Following the 2004 drawing...
  - All-cash ticket with three top winners paid monthly over time.
  - Books became Individual Tickets.
4. Paper prices had been increasing.
5. Savings from less printing were rolled into the program resulting in over \$108,000 in cash prizes.

# A Little History...

6. Council rebates increased!
7. All turn-ins were/are mailed to the ST.
8. Tickets were/are delivered via the roadshows.
9. Standardized format from year to year.

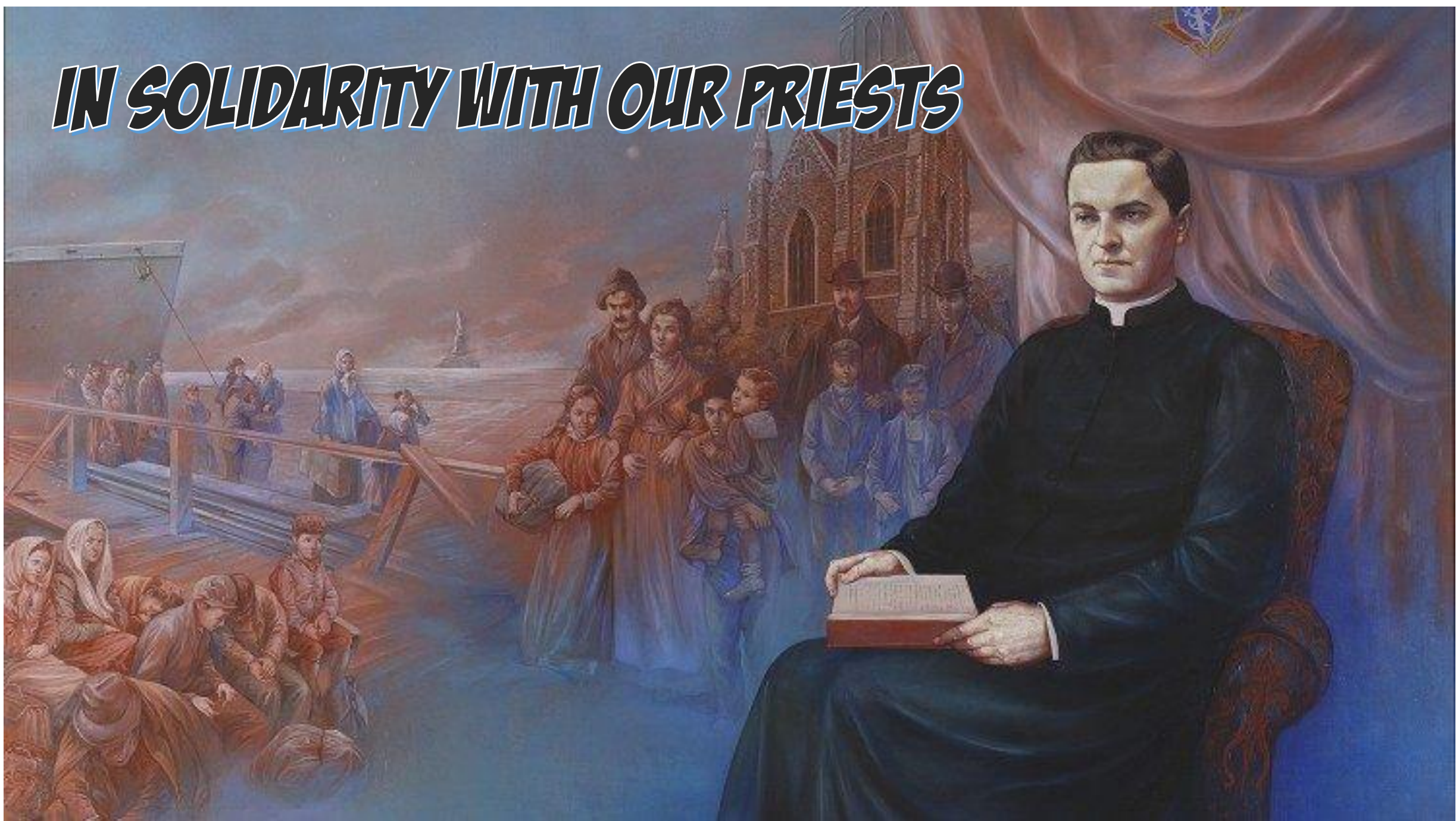

**As you can see this has not been done since PSD Ken Toigo in 1987, 37 years ago and we were only 3,821 short last year. We only need 1.9% increase across the state this year to break the barrier! 112 Councils Did Not Sell!**

- Fun Facts from 2023
  - Councils Sold >1000 Tickets (47)
  - Councils Sold >10 Tickets/Member (41)
  - Councils Sold Zero (0) Tickets (112)
  - Councils Sold Between 0.01 & 2.97 (95)

That 95 Councils represents over 16,200 members! If each of these councils sold 40 or more tickets, that would have been 3800 more.

**We were only 3,821 short last year to hit that magic number of 200,000.**

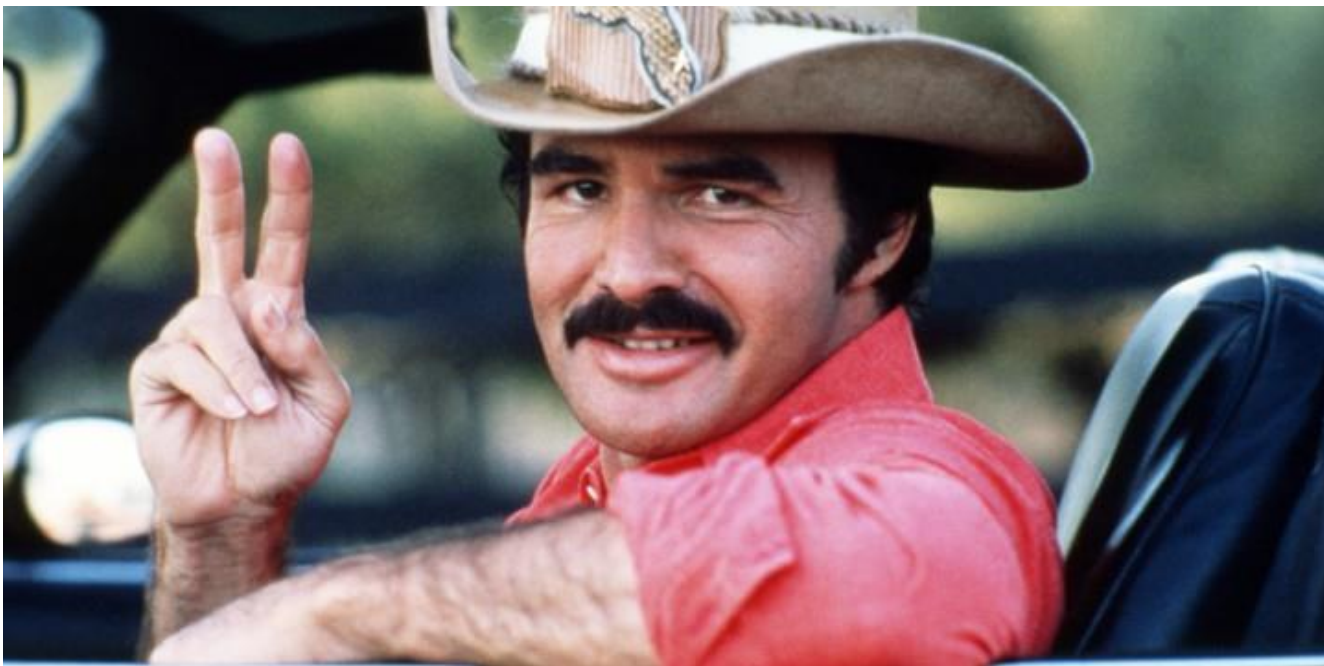

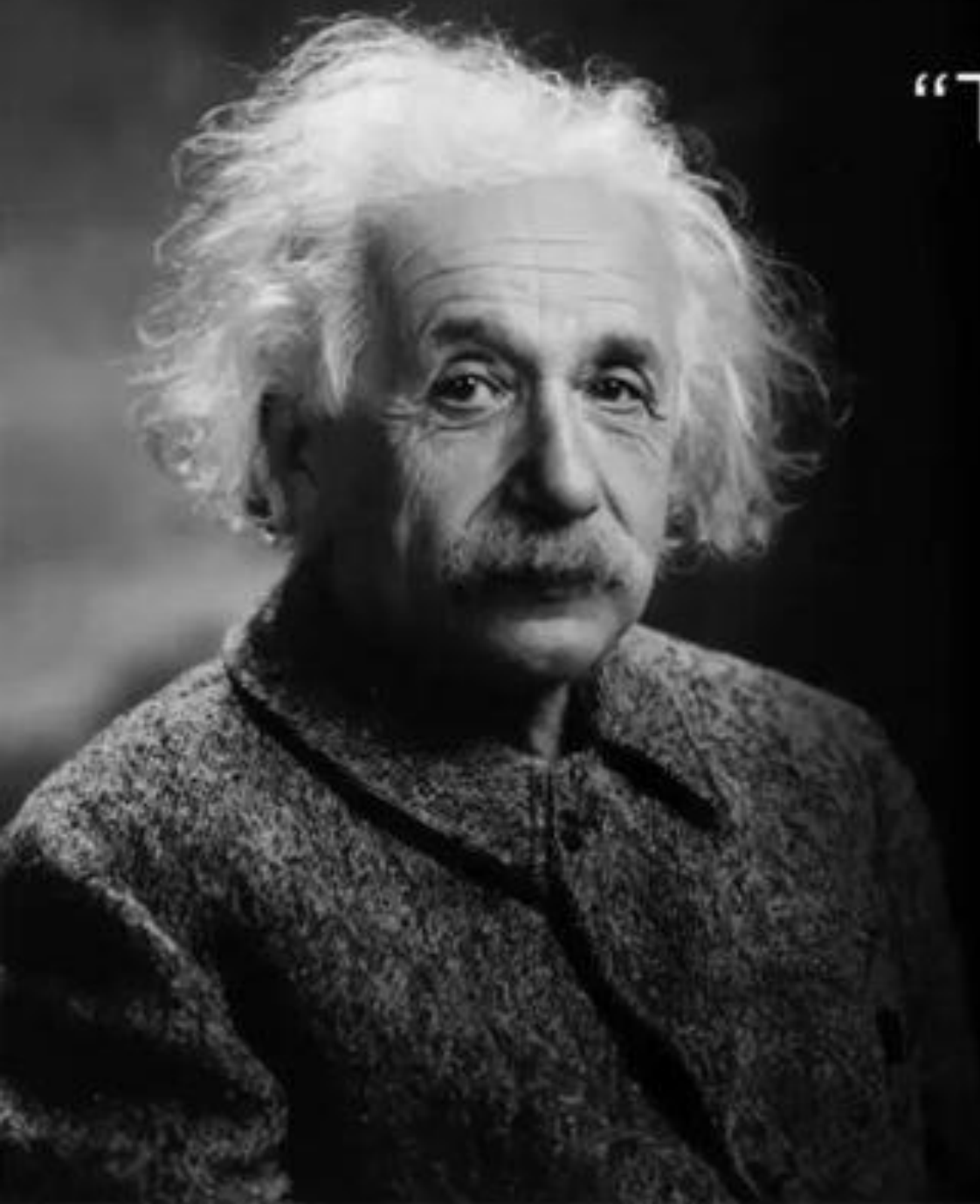

# **PARTNERING & MAILING**

**I know what you are thinking. I, you, and we only want councils to partner to sell more tickets to make more money for the Charity Foundation. That is furthest from the truth, well at least <2% of the truth.**

**Working with outside organizations and mailing to the entire membership, including active and inactive, is the easiest and quickest way to increase sales and rebates.**

**This is why we continue to stress partnering.**

# Super Ca\$h Bonanza 2024...Partnering

- Guidelines for Recruiting Outside Groups
  - Agree on a commission for selling Charity tickets
  - Make the commission attractive between \$2 and \$4 per ticket sold
  - Line up as many groups as possible to sell tickets
  - Collect sold tickets for highest 1<sup>st</sup> Phase turn-in rebate (April 1<sup>st</sup>)

# Super Ca\$h Bonanza 2024...Partnering

- Guidelines for Recruiting Outside Groups
  - They must return \$5 for every ticket sold
  - Immediately write them a check for tickets sold
  - Encourage 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase Participation
  - Search for organizations during the entire campaign
  - Councils earn all rebates from tickets sold

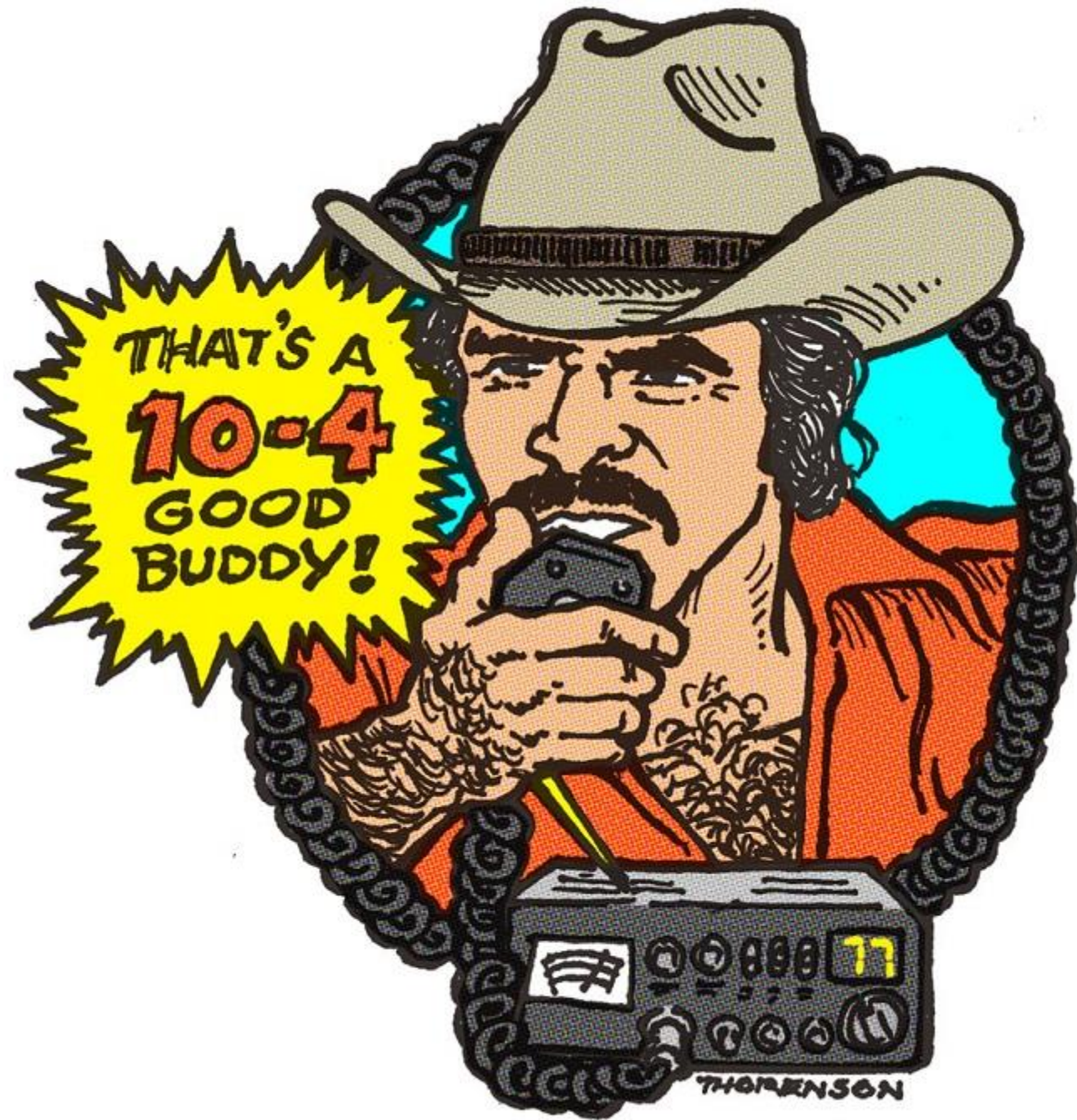

  - Make sure all 1<sup>st</sup> Phase tickets sold are sent to the State Treasurer by April 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Max your rebates with at least 4 tickets per member on 1<sup>st</sup> Turn-In
  - Work with outside organizations

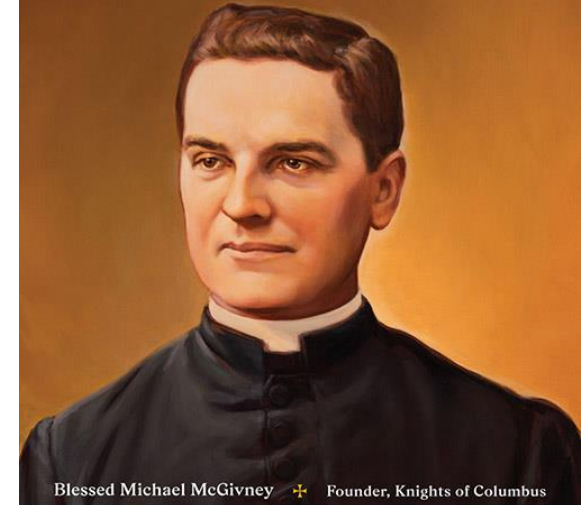
