


⁶⁶ Above all else, the Knights of Columbus exists to protect the Catholic family — by strengthening the Catholic man. We seek to help men become better husbands, better fathers and better disciples of Christ our King.

We have pursued this mission since the 1880s, when the first Knights gathered in a parish basement in New Haven, Connecticut. Our Founder, Blessed Michael McGivney, recognized that Catholic families in his parish were under siege. Young men in particular were being pulled away from the faith. Fathers were turning to non-Catholic groups, while many others died in the factories. Father McGivney created the Knights to confront this crisis, and, clearly, he was on to something.

What started with a handful of men in a parish basement has grown to more than 2 million members. The Knights of Columbus is now the world's largest lay Catholic organization — and most of our men are husbands and fathers. To this day, we aim to help them embrace God's call to be protectors, providers and the spiritual leaders of their families. And if anything, I believe that our mission has become even more important. In many ways, the challenges facing the family in the 19th century pale in comparison to the challenges we now face in the 21st century.








Defending a culture of life

What you can do:

- Identify potential new Knights. There are men in your parish who would be strong members. Talk to them.
- Councils and field agents should collaborate on recruitment efforts.
- Explain our mission. Catholic men may think they know what Knights of Columbus is, especially at the local level, but they may not have the whole picture of the broader organization. Share how the Knights is pointing the world to Jesus Christ.
- Invite them to join online right away by visiting <u>kofc.org/Join</u> and helping them complete the form. Don't forget to make sure they confirm their membership by opening their email and clicking the "Confirm Membership" button.
