CORE RESPONSIBILITIES

-  **Regular Council Visits:** Meet with officers to coordinate growth and offer guidance.
-  **Compliance and Reporting:** Ensure timely submission of forms #185, #365, SP7, #1295, and #1728.
-  **Fraternal Insurance:** Actively promote KofC insurance program benefits to protect member families.
-  **District Meetings:** Conduct midyear and organizational meetings to foster district collaboration.



REQUIRED FRATERNAL REPORTING



Routine Reports

Submit accurate reports of district events and regular local visitations:

- **State Exemplification Report (450):** Submit online immediately following any degree exemplification in your district.
- **DD Visitation Report:** Document meetings, officer updates, and local council health checks.






DD Annual Report (944)

DEADLINE: SEPTEMBER 15

Failing to submit Form 944 by September 15 directly disqualifies the district deputy from earning the Star District Award.



QUARTERLY EXPENSE REPORTING

-  **Strict Quarterly Cycles:** Supreme only accepts reporting grouped by fiscal quarters: Q1 (Jul-Sep), Q2 (Oct-Dec), Q3 (Jan-Mar), and Q4 (Apr-Jun).
-  **Due to DDD by Day 5:** Expense reports must be submitted to the District Deputy Director by the 5th day following a quarter (Oct 5, Jan 5, Apr 5, Jul 5).
-  **State Council Coordination:** The DDD coordinates with the State Deputy (SD) to submit all files to Supreme by the 10th day.



FORM 267 CLAIMS & LIMITATIONS



Approved Claim Process

Maximize your fraternal travel reimbursement

- **Official Supreme PDF:** You must complete the Supreme PDF Version of Form 267 only.
- **Receipt Directive:** Physical or digital receipts are required for all non-mileage operational costs.
- **Direct Pay:** Checks are sent directly to individual DDs from Supreme within 2 weeks.






Excluded Expenses

Certain fraternal items cannot be compiled or claimed under Form 267 expenses:

- **Assembly Exclusions:** Fourth Degree related costs are ineligible.
- **Chapter Restrictions:** Regional Chapter activities cannot be listed.
- **State Exclusions:** Ohio State Council (OSC) activities are ineligible.

DD WEEKEND EXPENSE REPORTING

-  **Two-Week Reporting Limit:** Complete and submit the OSC DD Reimbursement Form to the DDD within 2 weeks of DD Weekend completion (e.g., Jan 25).
-  **Supreme Mileage & Hotel:** Covers 100% round-trip mileage at \$0.30/mile and 2 nights of hotel lodging booked at the standard meeting block rate.
-  **Meals & Spousal Support:** Covers 2 DD meals (Friday Dinner / Sunday Lunch, no alcohol). Wives receive a per diem of \$35/day (\$70 total) if they attend.



DD WEEKEND: STATE LODGING RULES



OSC Fully Covered Meals: Saturday Breakfast, Saturday Lunch, Saturday Dinner, and Sunday Breakfast are covered by OSC. Do NOT include them on your report!



Crucial Hotel Block Integrity: OSC negotiates a specific room block. If we fall short of the night quota, the State Council faces heavy financial penalties.



Do NOT Search External Rates: Never book external discount rates (AAA, AARP, Military, etc.). Register and book early using the official OSC block!

Cor and the Columbian Award

- **Requirement 3** – Complete 3 programs / activities:
- one to bring men closer to Christ,
- one to build fraternity (strengthen the bonds of friendship between the men of your council and/or parish)
- and one to support your parish or community.
- These programs / activities can be unique to the council and do not need to be Faith in Action programs.
- You cannot claim programs / activities already submitted for requirements 2 and 3



Cor and the Columbian Award continued...

- **Conducting Cor satisfies all three of the program/activity criteria for requirement 3.**
- Councils must implement and sustain Cor gatherings that feature prayer, formation, and fraternity at least once per month. **To qualify, Cor must be implemented starting on or before April 1 with plans for long-term sustainability.**
- Cor may be held in conjunction with an additional men's ministry and pull from non-KofC content.

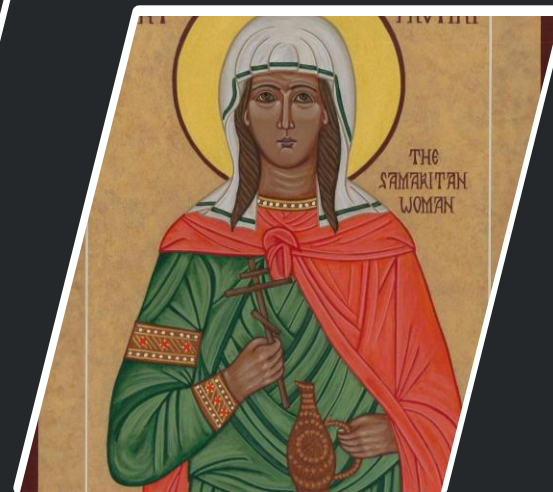

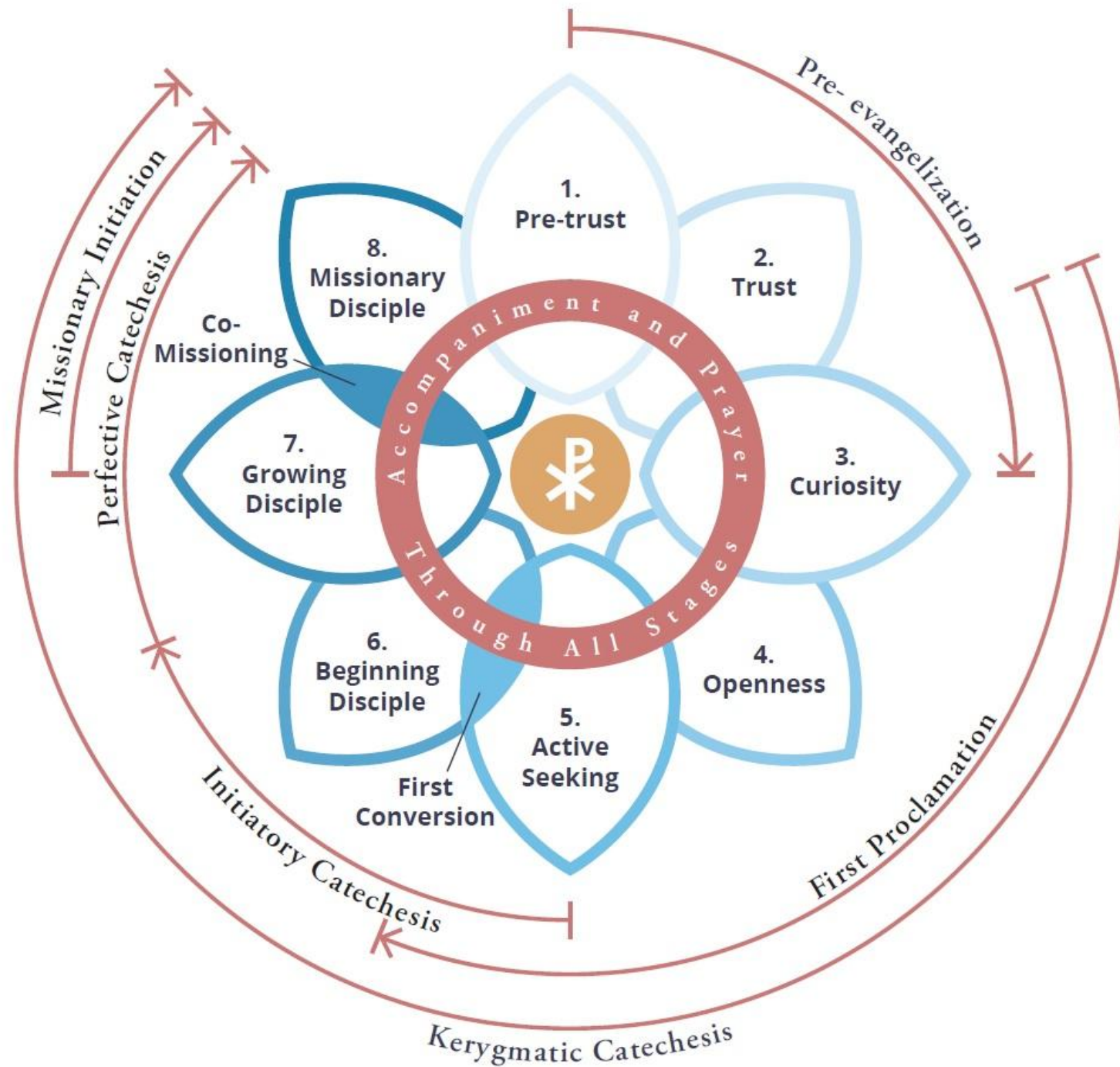
Name means:

The Enlightened One - The Luminous One - She Who Brings Light

Life:

- She was baptized after Christ's Resurrection.
- She traveled widely preaching the Gospel - including **Carthage** and eventually **Rome**.
- She became known for boldly proclaiming Christ despite persecution.
- During the reign of **Nero**, Photini and members of her family were arrested for preaching Christianity.
 - She refused to renounce Christ.
 - She endured torture and imprisonment.
 - Her witness converted many people, including some associated with Nero's household.
 - She eventually died as a martyr, reportedly being **cast into a well** after enduring various tortures.

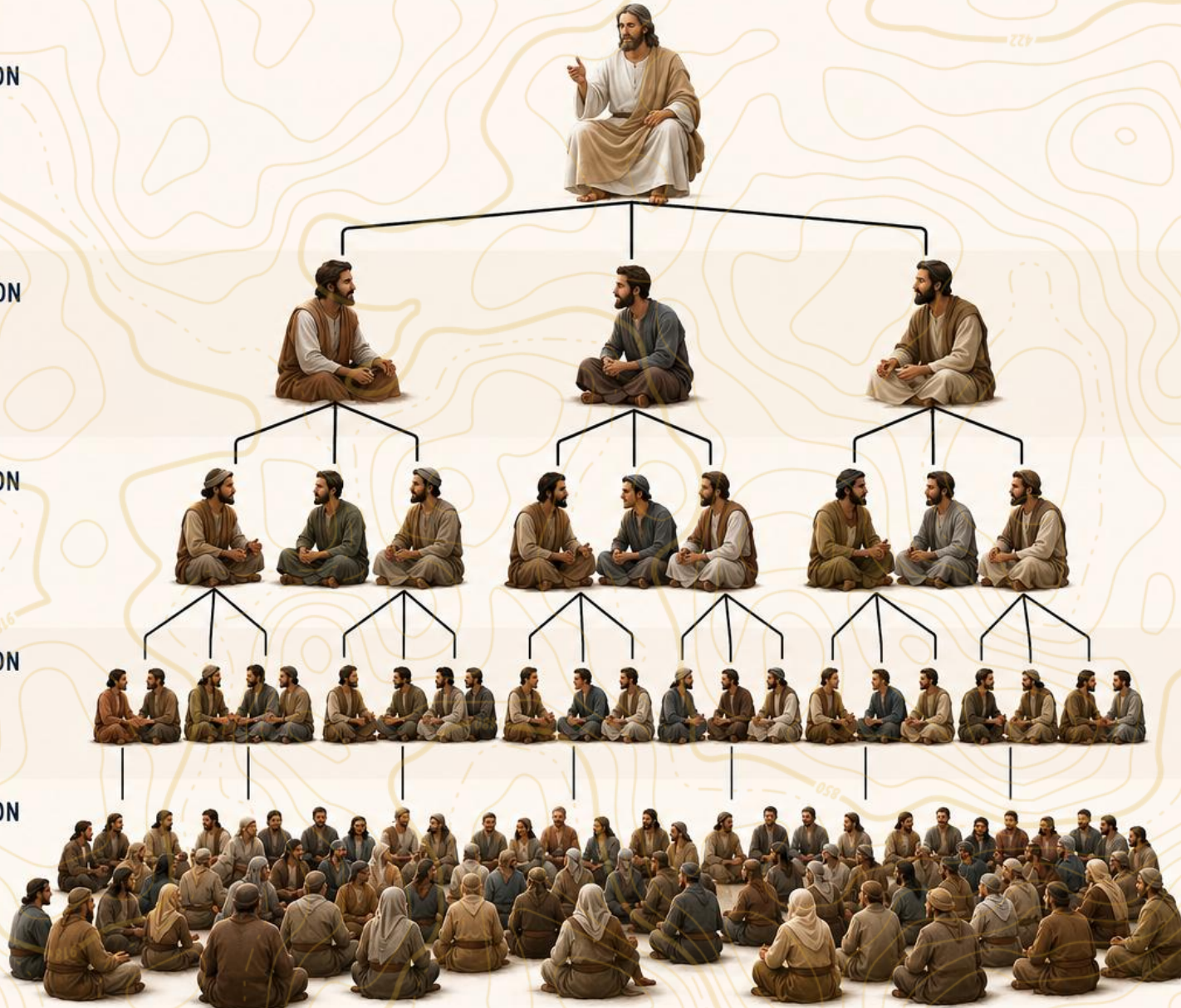

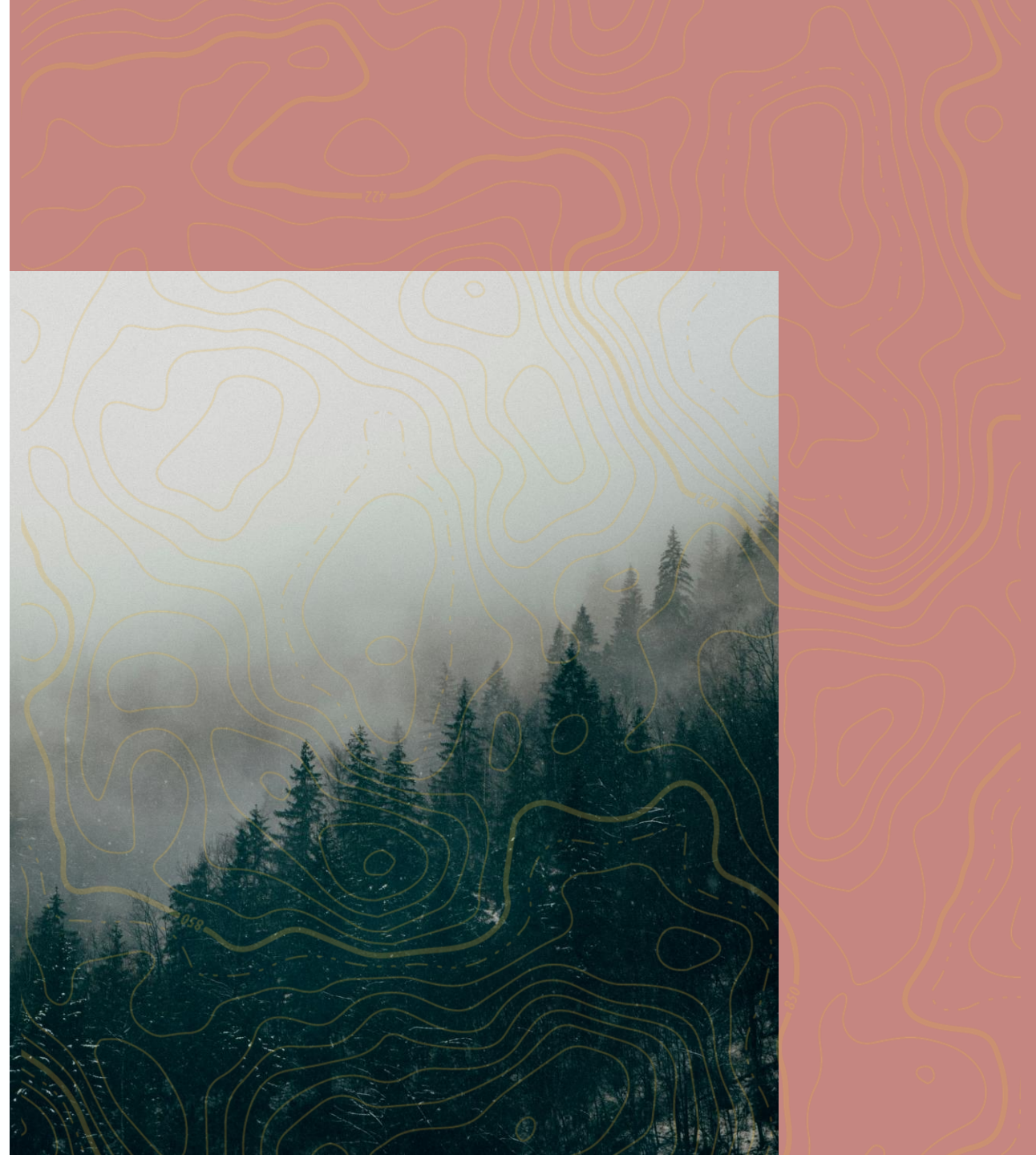

- **Council submits list of names, their Membership Number, and phone number of Associate or new Members to the Field Agent or General Agent.**
- **Field Agents reports the names of members that were contacted to the Council.**



2. 2026-2027 Founders' Award: PROCEDURE



- Grand Knight then submits Form 11077 to Supreme. (Renamed Member/Agent Meeting Report.) You can submit report as the names are received from the Field Agent or submit in groups.**





#11077 Member/Agent Meeting Report (26-27)



The Founders' Award recognizes excellence in the promotion of our insurance and fraternal benefits. To earn this award, new or associate members must meet individually with their local Field Agent for a financial review. If the council does not have a Field Agent, the meeting can be scheduled with their General Agent.

- The number of members that need to meet with their Field Agent or General Agent must equal or exceed:
 - A number equal to 10% of Associate members on the July 1 council roster
 - Minimum of 5 / Maximum of 15
 - You can track your council's quota & progress under the Membership tab in Officers Online
- To qualify, meetings must be with new or associate members

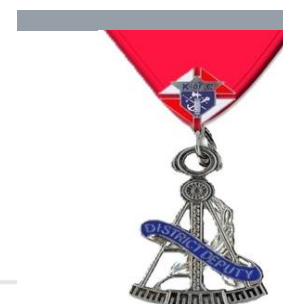

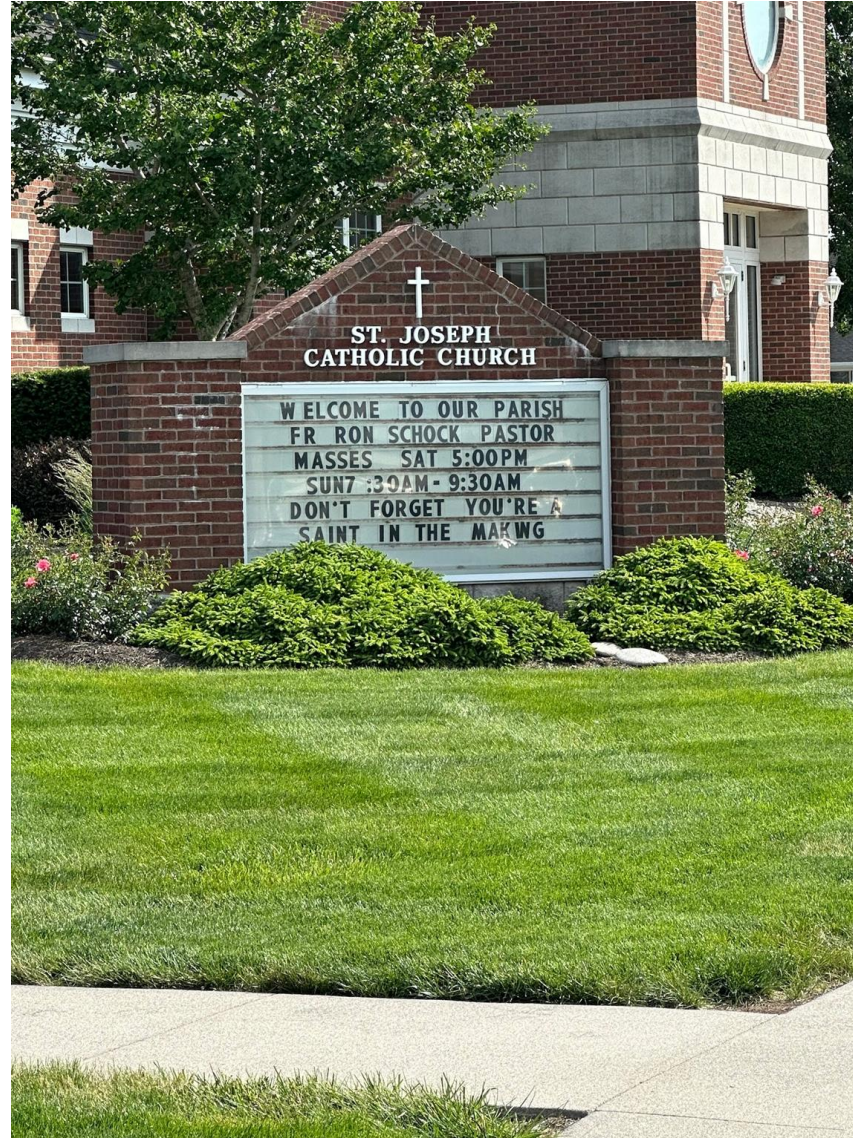

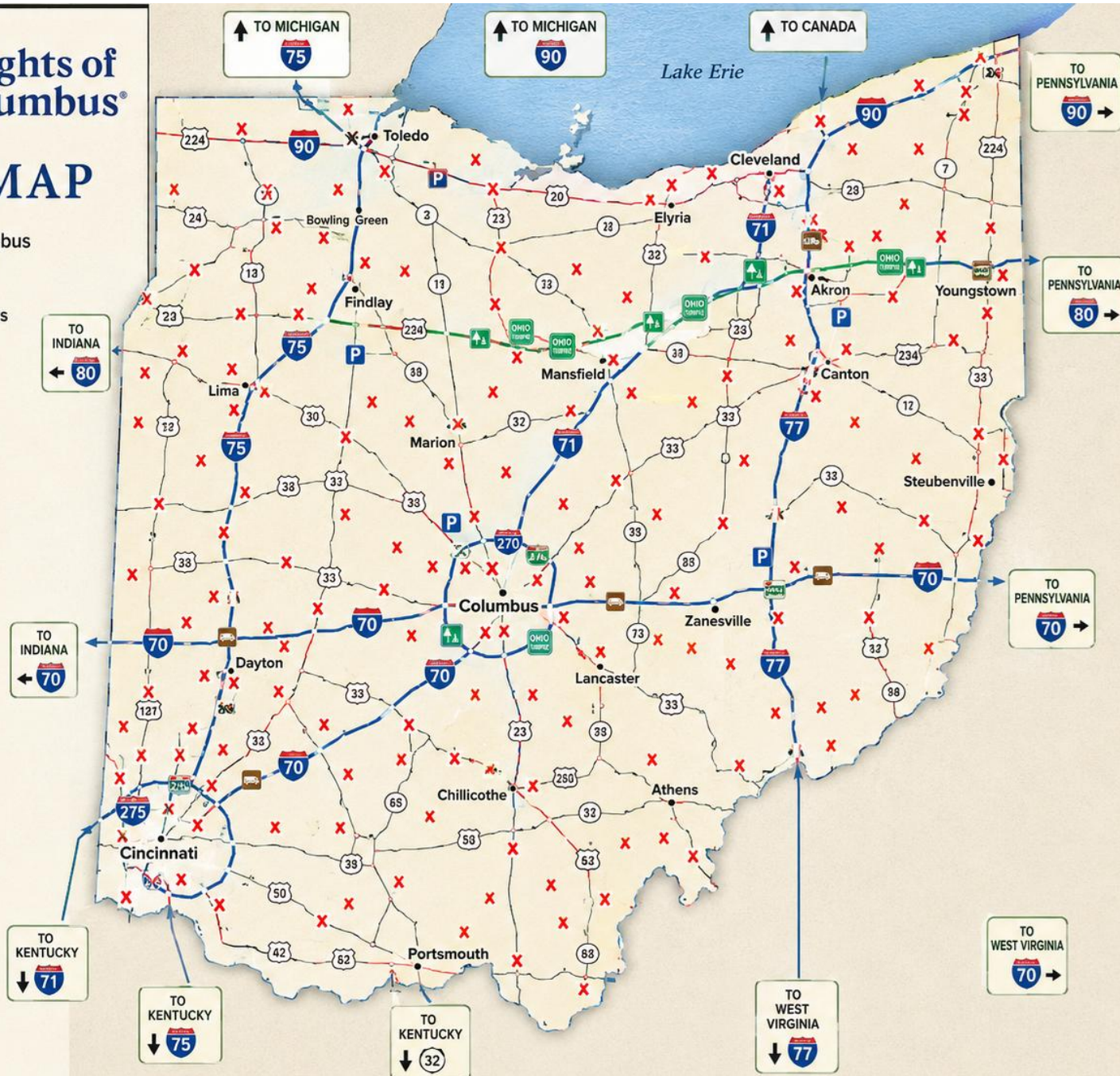




OHIO MAP

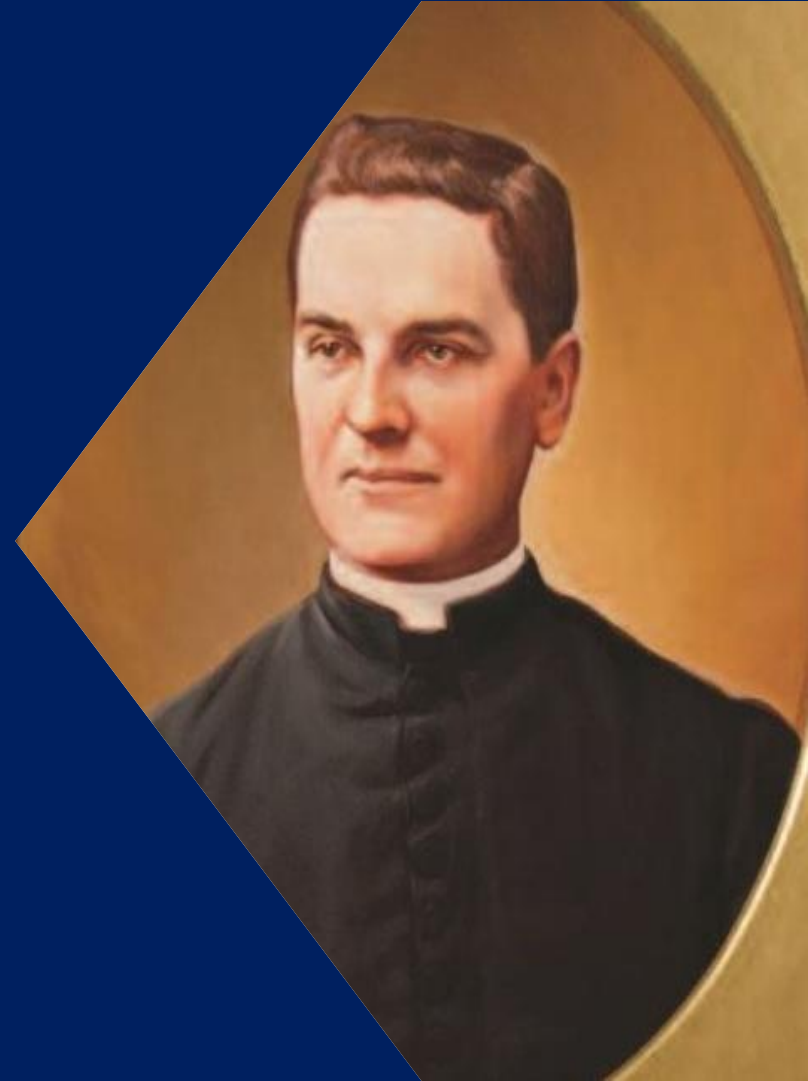
Prayer for the Canonization of Blessed Michael McGivney

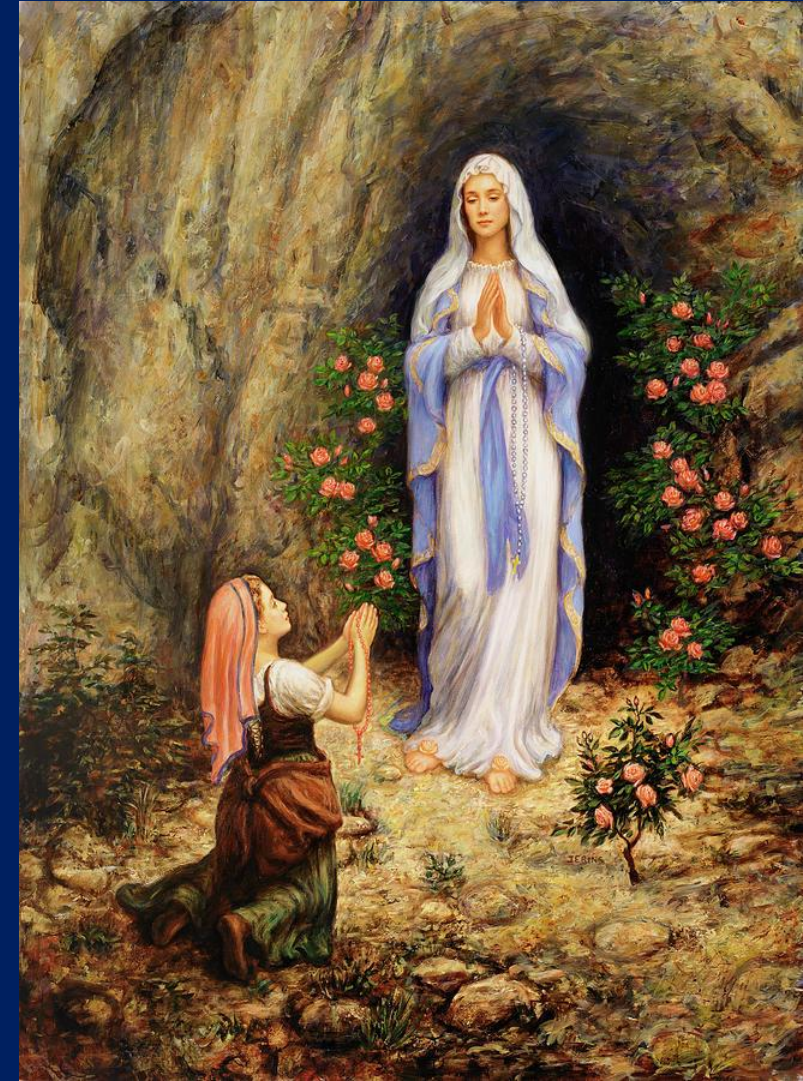


A Prayer to Our Lady of Lourdes

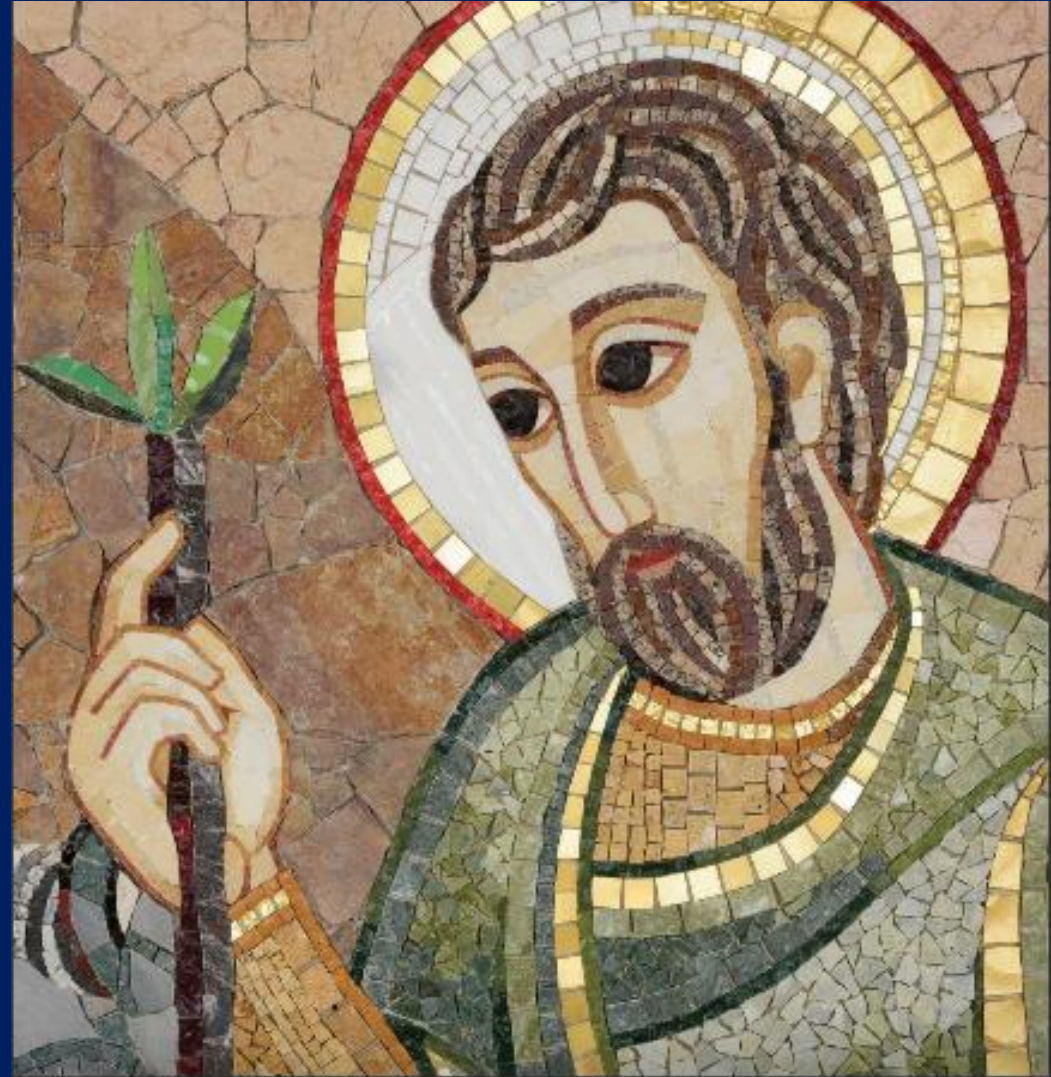


Prayer to St. Joseph
